- 1) **Call To Order/Attendance:** Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM. Commissioners Coit, Ballinger, Bonnano and Pianka present. Commissioner Tarasevich absent.

- 2) **Public Comment:** None
  
- 3) **Approval of minutes from WPCA Regular Meeting March 8,2022:**

- 4) **Financial Update:** \$4,435.31 in the checking account as of 06/07/22. Pianka noted a balance of \$2,793.98 from one year ago.
  
- 5) **Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF)- SFY 2023-----Status Update:**  
Application is in process. No new information at this time.
  
- 6) **Discussion: Sewer and Water Extension Design Plans prepared by Anchor Engineering, Dated 06/30/17:** Plans were reviewed with discussion of completion of design plans to include the terminus to be at the Montville town line, to include some additional affected properties between South Road and the Montville town line. It was discussed that the crossing of the Trading Cove Brook cost was the reason that the 2017 design plans ended at South Road. Depending on the results of the DWSRF Grant the additional distance may be designed.  
**Ballinger commented:** Stockhouse Road grant of \$5 million will be received and USDA grant money/40 year loan would be the next step in the process.  
**Bonnano commented:** Elaine Street inclusion in the sewer system if the project were to move forward
