FIRST SELECTMAN'S CORNER

The **AirGas Plant** on Stockhouse Road has returned to normal operations after a two-month effort to replace cooling towers. The rental units that were installed, until the new equipment arrived, emanated louder than normal noise which could be heard in the area. Plant Manager, Nick Tamburrino, initially reported that it would take about 60-90 days to rectify, and we are pleased that it was corrected well before that.

The **recent snowstorm** produced extremely heavy and slushy snow. The plowing efforts resulted in several **mailboxes** being affected. The Town does not presently have a policy regarding replacement but we worked with several residents to bring things back to "normal". What must be addressed are inordinate mailbox configurations i.e., custom set-ups that are prone to damage by snow/slush being cleared from roadways versus actual striking of the mailbox by the plow. Most Town policies simply provide a standard mailbox and post, installed, as the remedy, regardless of what may have been constructed or in place at the time of the occurrence. We will look into this further.

The UConn T2 Training Institute has announced that DOT will be providing two portable solar digital **speed monitoring signs** that we can move about town to make residents aware of their actual speed. The units will also collect data and the information can become available to the State Police if so requested. We constantly get complaints of speeding and of vehicular passing on our narrow roadways. The units are scheduled to arrive by mid-month and will be deployed shortly thereafter.

COVID-19 VACCINATION CLINIC TODAY

There will be a free, walk-up COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic at **Fields Memorial School**, Bozrah, Connecticut from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM on Friday, March 4, 2022 specifically for children ages 5-12 in our community. However, the vaccine is available to anyone in the community.

No appointment necessary! The Connecticut Department of Public Health and local providers are bringing the DPH Vaccination Vans to our town to make the COVID-19 vaccine more accessible to our community, so be on the lookout for the yellow SUV when you arrive.
