First Selectman' Corner

The new **street name signs** are being installed. They are larger format and with blue background. "T" intersection guardrails and/or warning signs have been installed at pertinent locations. The lower section of Wawecus Hill Road will finally have the last of the decayed wooden post and cable style guardrails replaced within the next month.

Stanton Hill Road will receive new cross culvert drainage piping and catch basins commencing on **Monday, May 16 from 7:30AM-3:00PM daily for about three weeks** in preparation for regrind and resurfacing of the deteriorated roadway surface. There will be some-re-routing of traffic: Fitchville Road to the dig site on Stanton Hill will be available (which will move to four different locations along the road as the project progresses) and from Gilman Road to Stanton Hill Road Extension to Stanton Hill Road to get to the other side of the worksite(s). The open trenches will be covered by steel plates after each workday to allow for unimpeded evening/overnight travel along the roadway. Roadside mowing and street sweeping will be postponed to allow the full DPW crew to work on this project in order to coordinate with the paving crews schedule.

The **Bozrah Memorial Day Parade** will take place on **Saturday May 28, 2022**. There will be a memorial ceremony at the WW1 Memorial at 11:30 which then moves to the Veterans Memorial at Town Hall. The parade will step off at 1PM and will conclude at the Moose for trophy presentation and refreshments. **There will be 12 trophies awarded:** 1) Best FD Uniformed Personnel 2) Best FD Tanker 3) Oldest FD Truck 4) Newest FD Truck 5) Best FD Horse Drawn Unit 6) Best FD Tower or Ladder Truck 7) Best Antique Truck 8) Best Antique Car 9) Best Business Vehicle 10) Best Float 11) Best Tractor and 12) Best Marching Group.
